Minimizing reporting burden:

- Same indicator reported to several organizations (EMCDDA, ECDC, UNAIDS) -
 - it would be optimal to report on one indicator only once by country
 - Harmonization of data collection between organizations
- TDI and DRID data reporting should be harmonized - thus countries do not have to double report on the same issue

Minimizing reporting burden in Fonte:

- In case of serobehavioural studies there is a double reporting in ST9 P2 and P3 (gender, young /new IDUs, years since first injection)
- ST9 - if geographical breakdown is reported in different sheets – the total should be calculated from it
- The Fonte should calculate the proportions automatically – there is a possibility for errors.
- Commas (in proportions) have to be changed to dots at present.

Fonte reporting – further issues:

- Optional item: Opioid and non-opioid categories could be broken down into more specified categories (e.g: amphetamines; cocaine; cathinones or “other” category) – it would have added value while interpreting data
- In case of serobehavioral surveys: as an optional item risk behaviors and HIV/HCV could be connected in reporting (such at present: years since first injection; age; gender in ST9 P2)
- Issue of N of cases and self-report - explicit if they should be reported or not (Luxembourg rarely has prevalence surveys, annual reporting is possible only by self-report, N of cases is under 10 in case of notifications, which is not to be reported)
- Sometimes separation of LT and treatment setting data is not feasible – in Hungary in the seroprevalence survey service providers with integrated setting were also included (separation could be done by open or closed setting)

Minor issues:

- DRID expert not in the Focal Point (not responsible for uploading the table but fills the offline or Excel form) stays out of the communication of EMCDDA and NFP carried out at the Fonte surface
- It would be helpful to receive the Quality Feedback every year in time (April-May) before the new NR – so that recommendations can be taken into consideration.
